### PRIOR TO THE WORKSHOP DAY:

#### Space:

- Classroom with a white board and dry erase markers
- Students on rug (if available) or at desks

#### Surface:

- Student desks clear of materials if students are working at their desks
- Extraneous clutter removed

#### Assistance:

- One teacher per thirty-five students

#### Equipment:

- Chairs for students and artist
- Student nametags (first name only in large, clear print)
- CD player at the front of the classroom

### ON WORKSHOP DAY:

#### Arrival:

- 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up

#### Parking:

- One space near the venue

#### Assistance:

- No special assistance needed

#### Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the workshop space, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
